The Vasai court on Friday directed the Tulinj police to register a case of murder and negligence against all the doctors involved in the wrong blood transfusion to a 27-year-old woman just after she had given birth leading to her death in Sep 2013.

The Nalasopara police, which was handling the case earlier, had registered a case of accidental death. Rama Shankar Yadav, husband of Seema Yadav, has been trying to establish that his wife's death was a result of negligence and not an accident.

Seema, a resident of Nalasopara, delivered a healthy baby boy at Jivdani Seva Hospital

in Nagindas Pada and was fit until the doctors transfused her blood. As her health deteriorated, she was shifted to Alliance Hospital where she passed away, reports DNA 4th April.
